He speaks candidly and frankly about his rise to fame and fortune, while continuing to make choices that negatively impacted his personal life and career.



Following a series of personal tragedies including the loss of more than 30 friends and family members due to lifestyle choices and negative behaviors, Marc recommitted his life to Christ. At this point, he was compelled to reach out to young people (and their parents) to encourage them to set goals, reaffirm or find their faith, and live compassionate Christ-centered fulfilling lives.

Marc Mero's message is changing the lives of students and congregations at every stop. During a recent visit to Russia, more than 400 people gave their lives to Christ and received the gift of salvation. According to Marc, "today, I am able to put my choices, good and bad, into perspective. It is clear that God saved me for a purpose. If I can change one person's life, my life has not been in vain."

Marc's message is powerful and entertaining, but ultimately, it inspires and moves people of all ages to make the right choices and dream big.
